



GraceKids Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Can I take my child to his/her classroom? OR Can my child come see me when I am working in the classroom? *R: For the safety of the children, only today's workers are allowed in the nursery area. Your child can be brought to the front or a message can be given to them.*

Q: It's 11, can I check my child into class? *R: Because we want to keep the teacher/child ratios at a safe level for the children, we close check in at 10:10. At that time, we make sure all the ratios are at safe levels and get extra teachers to serve if needed before the nursery leaders head into the service.*

Q: Can my child take their snack to class? *R: Because of the prevalence of food allergies, we do not allow any snacks to be brought to class. We offer food allergy friendly fruit snacks to children in Walkers, Twos, and Threes & Fours classes. All babies in the Newborns class are welcome to be dropped off with breastmilk or formula. If they have graduated to cow's milk, please inform us so that we be extra careful to keep it away from other babies (in case of milk allergies).*

Q: My child had diarrhea/was throwing up early this week but has been fine since. Can he/she come to class? *R: If your child has had any vomit, fever or diarrhea in the last 48 hours, we ask that you do not check them into nursery.*
